

## **SOP 12 - Vaccinating Animals for Specific Diseases**

<u>Purpose:</u> Vaccinating will help avoid compromising the herd when introducing new or returning animals. They will also control the spread of disease within a closed herd.

•	Do you vaccinate your cattle? YES or NO (Circle one)
•	Consult with Dr. (herd veterinarian) to establish any vaccination programs based on the herd's cattle health management plan.
	<ul> <li>Refer to vaccination programs provided by:</li> </ul>
•	Determine the specific vaccines that must be administered and the time at which vaccines and boosters must be administered to each new animal (refer to vet directions).
•	Vaccinate calves as indicated by herd veterinarian and product labels.
•	Document products, group of animals and any other information that is required for your vaccination program and record all required information contained in Record 10 (Livestock treatment records).
